Six Researchers from CNR-STEMS in the World's Top Scientists' List

Six researchers from CNR-STEMS in the World's Top Scientists' List drawn up by Stanford University: Osvalda Senneca, Valeria Di Sarli, Gianpaolo Pulcini, Carmen Branca, Riccardo Chirone and Adrian Irimescu.

The World's Top Scientists' List was recently published, the ranking, drawn up by Stanford University, of the most cited scientific researchers at international level in the various disciplines. This list is the result of a study that made it possible to select just under 160,000 names from around 7 million researchers around the world. 22 scientific areas and 176 sub-categories were examined, considering the years 1996 to 2019 as the reference period. Data were extracted from Scopus, one of the most important databases for scientific publications. The study appeared in the journal Plos Biology.
